The Lib Dem Focus Team has uncovered a major Council mess with the lights on the roads off **Essex Road**.

The lights are always on and have been for over a year, some say 18 months.

Apparently the new lamps were installed to run on a Central Management System (CMS) that would control them.

It was only after the **Focus Team** reported them and then chased the Council to fix the lights in the roads, that officers found that the CMS was not working.

Focus has now been told that they are dropping the system and all the lamps will be fitted with photo cells which will turn them off when it is light and on, when it gets dark.

Lib Dem Focus Team member Rupert Pickering says:

Residents have reported the lights for over a year so why has it taken so long to fix them? At last the Council has adopted a simple solution. We are pleased that our campaign to get the lights fixed has been taken seriously and we and the residents will be looking forward to see them working properly.

Dumping – Cavendish/Hainault

This problem of dumped furniture beside the flank wall of **1 The Pavement Hainault Road** has been on-going for a considerable time.

Focus is in regular contact with the council's Neighbourhood Manager who has arranged for the area to be cleared swiftly. He identified it as a 'hotspot' and confirmed that CCTV coverage has been ordered. Unfortunately, delivery is taking some time.

Gregg Close – update

Jordan Sullivan of the Focus Team has asked that the Council look into pruning back the trees or planting smaller trees in their place.

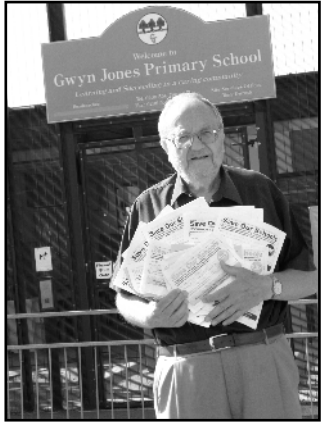


Massive trees in Chesterfield Road
